***Sacrifice* 趙氏孤兒 – *Chen Kaige* 陳凱歌**

Based on the classic play *Orphan of Zhao*, *Sacrifice* was written and directed by Chen Kaige, of *Farewell My Concubine* fame. It's the story of duplicitous dealings to seize power during the Yuan Dynasty in the 5th century, B.C. When the Zhao clan is wiped out by Tu'an Gu, a doctor named Cheng Ying rises up to take in the family's last survivor -- an infant prince. However, Tu'an Gu refuses to be anyone's fool, and he orders all newborns to be taken prisoner until the baby prince is surrendered. A tragic twist of fate leaves Cheng without his wife and his own son, but he raises the prince as his own. When the boy comes of age, will he rise up and take back the reign of leadership, or will he instead bow down to Tu'an, whom he now looks upon as his own godfather?
